



Purpose

The Australian Work Zone Memorial pays tribute to Australian roadworkers who have been killed while carrying out their duties in an active worksite¹. TMAA's initiative is inspired by a similar 2002 project launched by the American Traffic Safety Services Foundation in the United States. Like its American counterpart, the purpose of the Australian Work Zone Memorial is to honour lives lost in work zones and remind policymakers and drivers of the human impact of work zone fatalities.

TMAA invites submissions of names to be included on the memorial. Anyone may submit a name, but consent must be obtained from a family member before adding a name to the memorial.
